Topic Area	Comment
SCAG Survey of	Did SCAG ask different jurisdictions if they were designated as a healthy
Local Jurisdiction	community? Do we know how many there are? This would be helpful for
Policies	engaging with those that have not already become healthy community.
Bicycles	Concern about bicycle rack codes and their location in relation to the front of retail establishments.
Disadvantaged	The Bay Area has communities of concern that they identify. We should try to
Communities	identify them here in terms of transportation and land use impacts, instead of
	scrambling to identify census tracts.
Economic Issues	A lot of health and mobility problems over the last 60 years have been
	economically driven. Can we look at optimum economics, health, and mobility in SPM?
	Need to talk about healthcare savings to convince politicians to act accordingly.
Food	Encourage healthier food options, better connections to local farms. The siting
Accessibility	of healthy food establishments, grocery stores could be a land use strategy.
	Need policies that increase access to healthy food and decrease food deserts within the region.
Funding	Where does funding come from? Is public health part of state RTP guidelines?

Performance	Nail down what health indicators need to collect for modeling.
Measures	Quantify importance of safe sidewalks for aging baby boomers.
	Compare health/econ impacts of sitting in traffic vs active transportation.
	Look at affordable housing, density and availability and its effects on active
	transportation and public health.
	Analyze safety in terms of crime and intentional injury because personal safety
	affects active transportation rates.
	Analyze the cobenefits of promoting/including active transportation strategies?
	How do active transportation strategies impact top diseases/mortality in region?
