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



FIGURES 1-5 ARE BASED ON COMBINED TOTAL FOR THE REGION'S COUNTIES.



(Millions of Jobs)





(Thousands of Jobs)








Counties in SCAG Region




**FIGURE 6-1**


**FIGURE 6-2**


**FIGURE 6-3**


**FIGURE 6-4**


**FIGURE 7-1**


**FIGURE 7-2**


**FIGURE 7-3**


**FIGURE 7-4**


**FIGURE 8-1**


**FIGURE 8-2**


**FIGURE 8-3**





**FIGURE 8-4**

 (Percent)




**FIGURE 9-1**

(Thousands of Jobs)




**FIGURE 9-2**




**FIGURE 9-4**

(Percent)




**FIGURE 10-1**


**FIGURE 10-2**


**FIGURE 10-3**


**FIGURE 10-4**


**FIGURE 11-1**


**FIGURE 11-2**


**FIGURE 11-3**
