Bob Santos is Vice President of Five Point Communities, Inc., a spin-off subsidiary of the Lennar Corporation. Bob's efforts are focused on positioning Five Point Communities' significant master planned community assets for success in the future, with special emphasis on creating sustainable communities.

Prior to assuming his current role with Five Point Communities, he spent thirteen years with the Lennar Corporation. Bob performed a variety of leadership roles for Lennar, including serving as President for Lennar's Southern California Land Division, covering land development operations within seven Southern California counties.

Prior to joining Lennar, Bob spent a total of nine years with The Irvine Company. He started in the planning department working on the master plan for the 90,000 acre Irvine Ranch, and held the position of Vice President, Land Development for the northern portion of the Ranch.

Bob has conceived and directed community development programs that are successful in the marketplace while receiving some of the industry's most prestigious awards for planning, marketing and implementation, including honors from the Urban Land Institute, the National Association of Homebuilders, and the League of California Cities.

Bob is a member of the Urban Land Institute and currently chairs the ULI Orange County/Inland Empire District Council's newly formed Sustainable Communities Initiatives Council.
