4.2 <u>RTP Update</u>

John Asuncion, SCAG, reported the following:

- 27 Public Workshops for Connect SoCal, SCAG's 2040 RTP/SCS, were being held throughout SCAG region from mid-May through mid-June.
- SCAG staff had been developing Draft Connect SoCal report which was scheduled to be released in fall 2019.

4.3 <u>FTIP Update</u>

Mr. Asuncion, SCAG, reported the following:

- SCAG staff was analyzing 2019 FTIP Administrative Modification #19-08.
- 2019 FTIP Amendment #19-07 was under federal review for approval.
- All 2019 FTIP amendments through #19-06 had received full approved.
- Draft 2020 FTIP guidelines were being developed by SCAG staff and scheduled to be presented to TCWG in August 2019.
- 4.4 <u>EPA Update</u>

Wienke Tax, EPA Region 9, reported that EPA Region 9 Administrator had signed a proposed rule to approve 2008 8-hour ozone SIP and revisions to one-hour and 1997 8-hour ozone SIPs in 2016 South Coast Air Quality Management Plan (AQMP).

In response to a question, Karina O'Connor, EPA Region 9, confirmed that transportation conformity budgets in the South Coast ozone plans were proposed for approval while EPA had not taken action on Coachella Valley ozone SIP portion of 2016 South Coast AQMP.

4.5 <u>ARB Update</u>

Nesamani Kalandiyur, ARB, reported the following:

- EMFAC2019 was still under EPA review for approval.
- A public workshop was jointly held on May 16 by California Transportation Commission and ARB on proposed federal Safer Affordable Fuel-Efficient (SAFE) Vehicle Rule for Model Years 2021-2026 Passenger Cars and Light Trucks.

In response to questions, Karina O'Connor, EPA Region 9, stated that EPA staff was in process of consulting with FHWA Headquarters staff regarding grace period for EMFAC2017; EPA staff did not know when the SAFE Vehicle Rule would be finalized yet;
