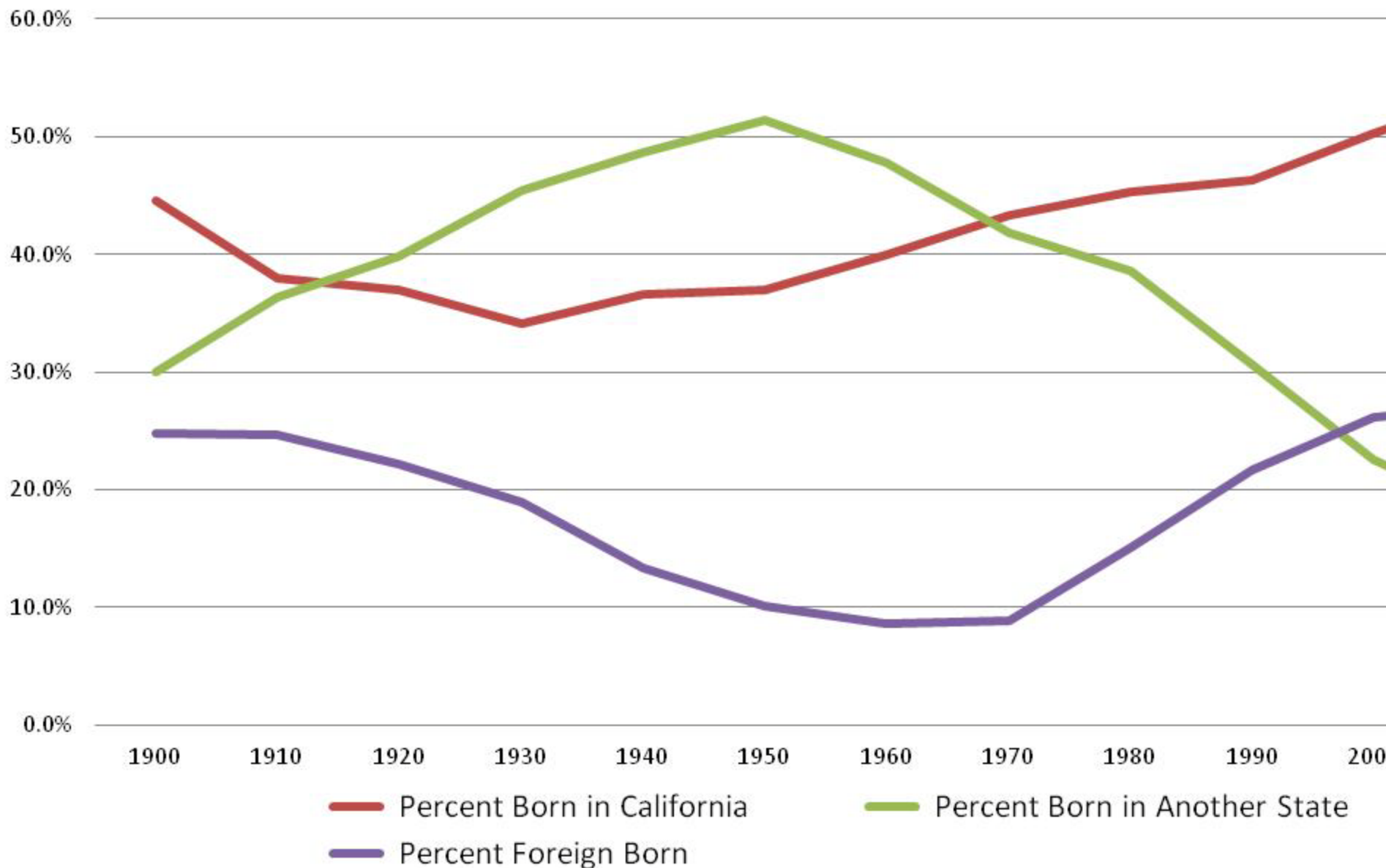

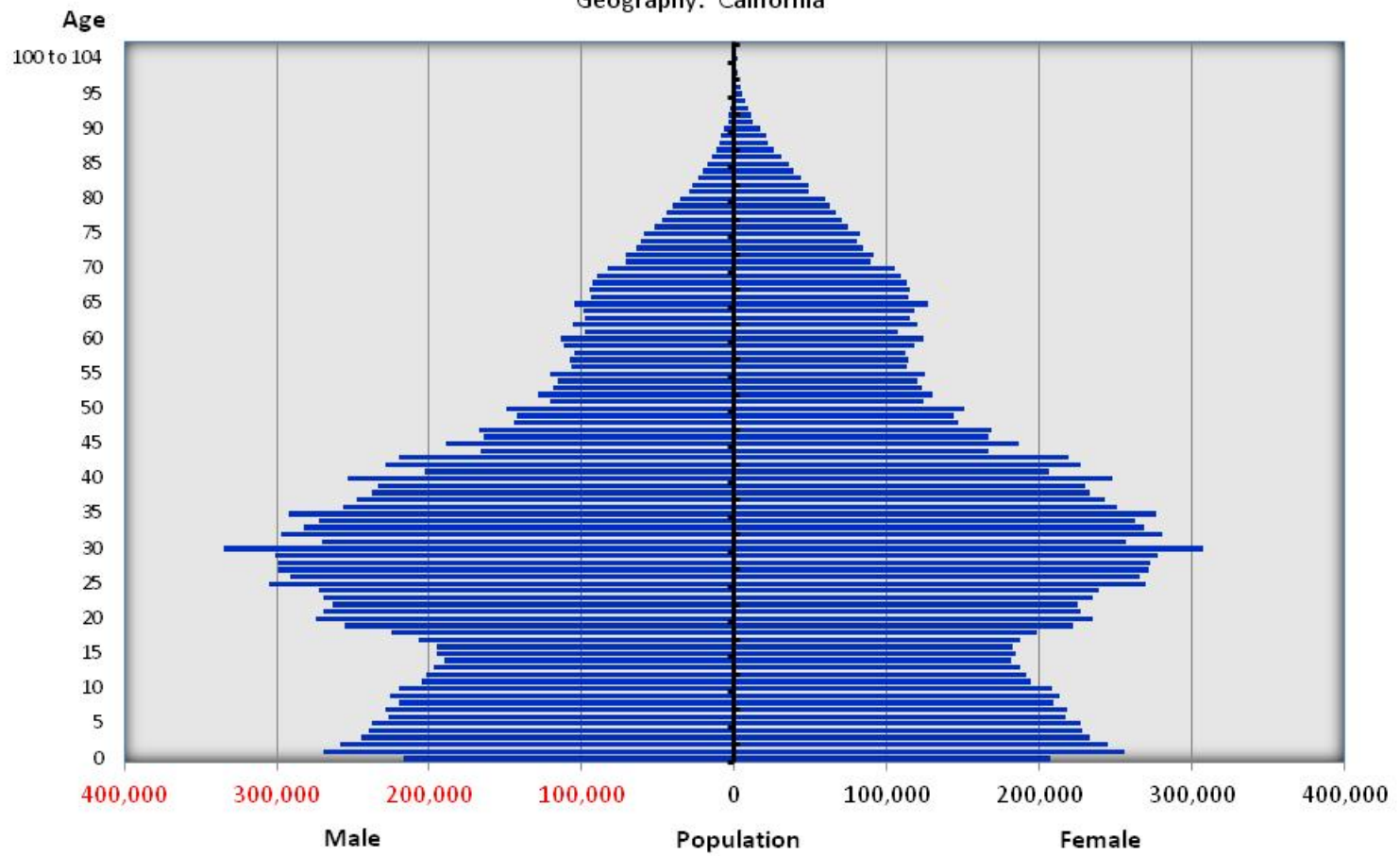
# Place of Birth of California Residents 1900-2010

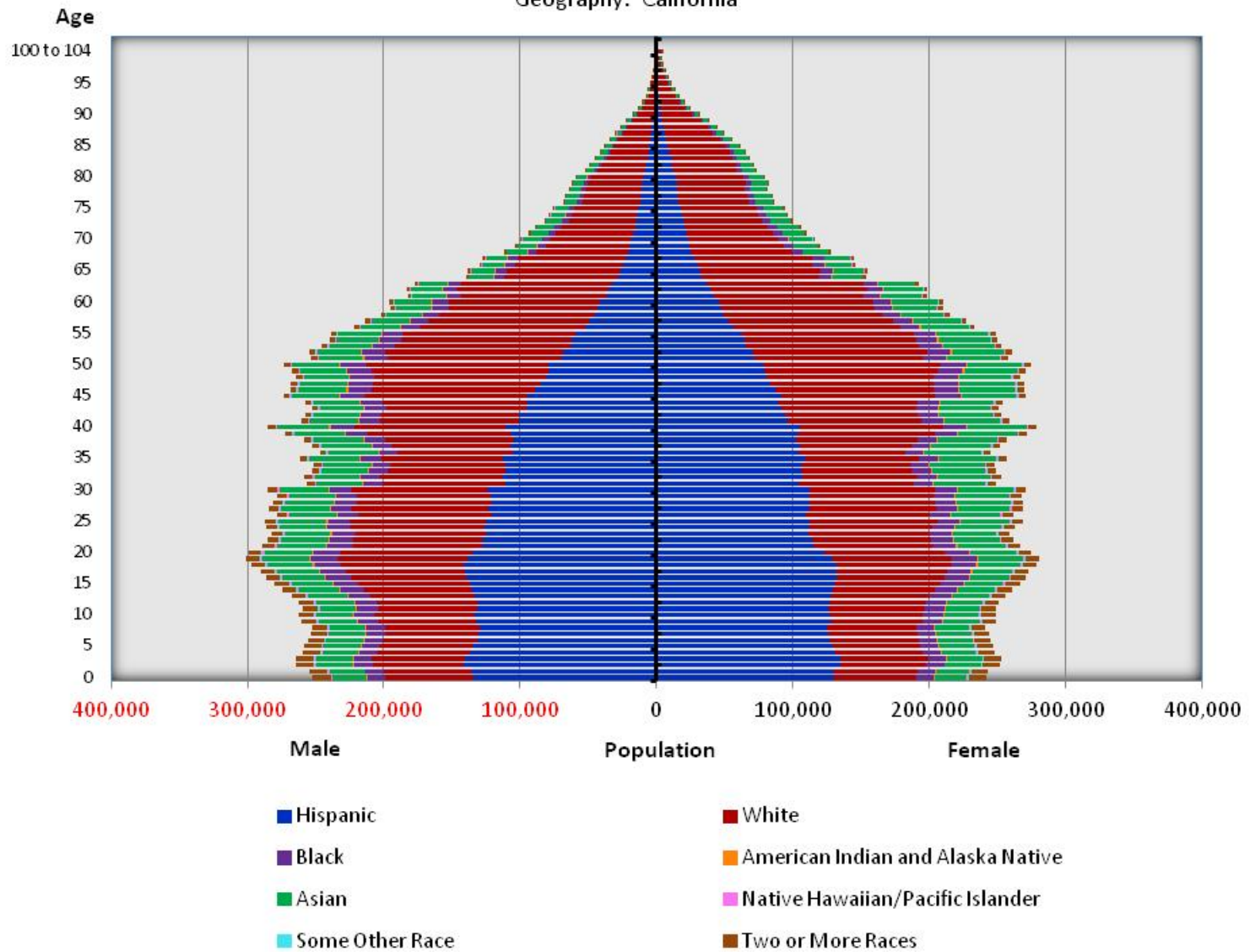

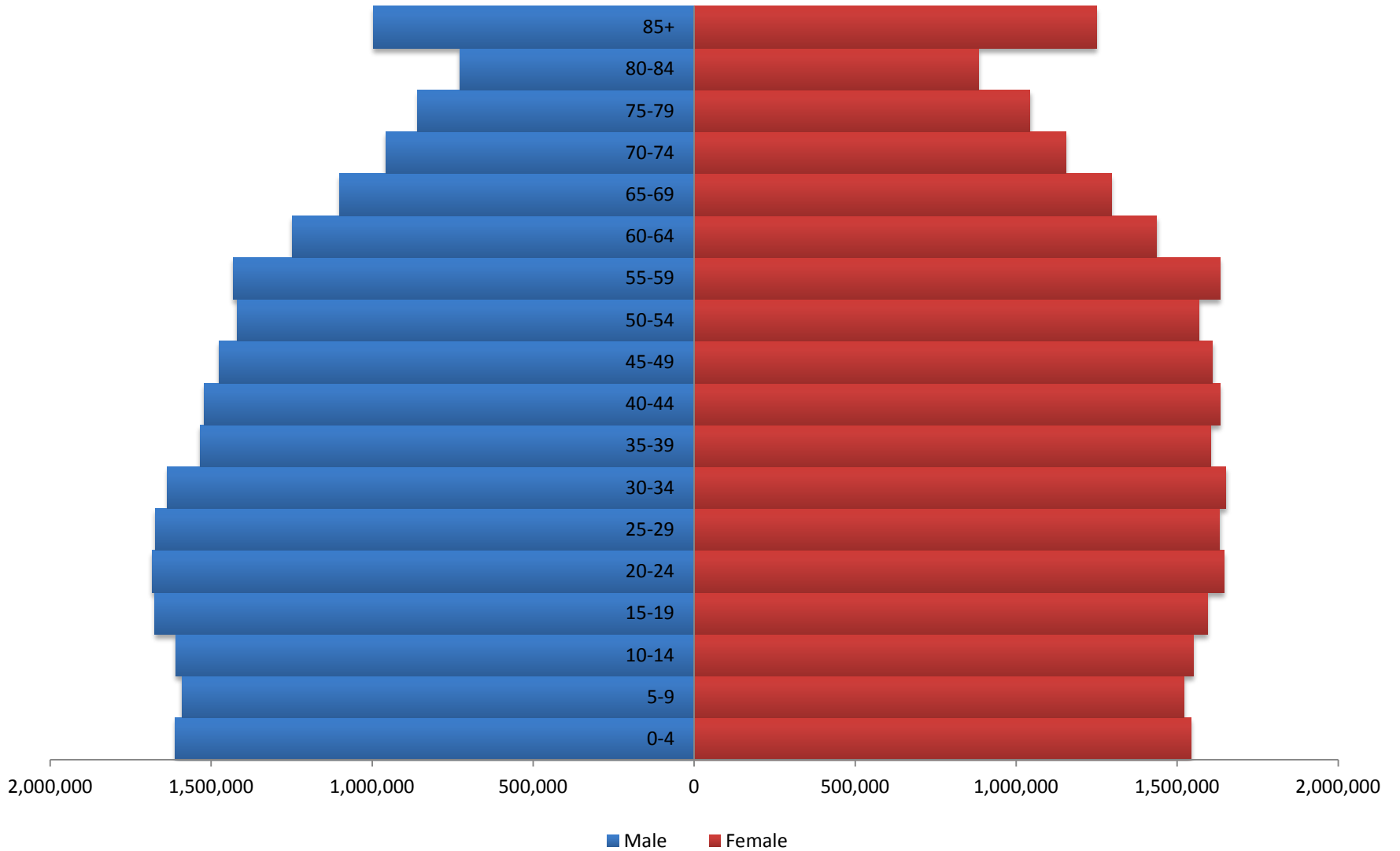
# 2010 Population by Age , Sex , Race/Ethnicity
