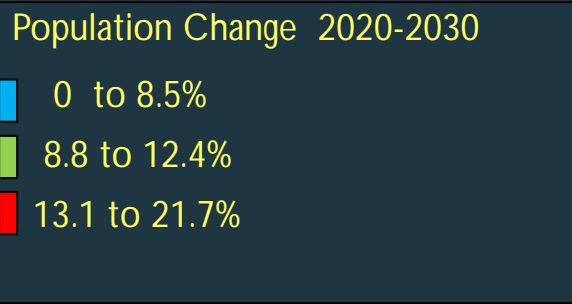
Percent Change in Population Census 2010

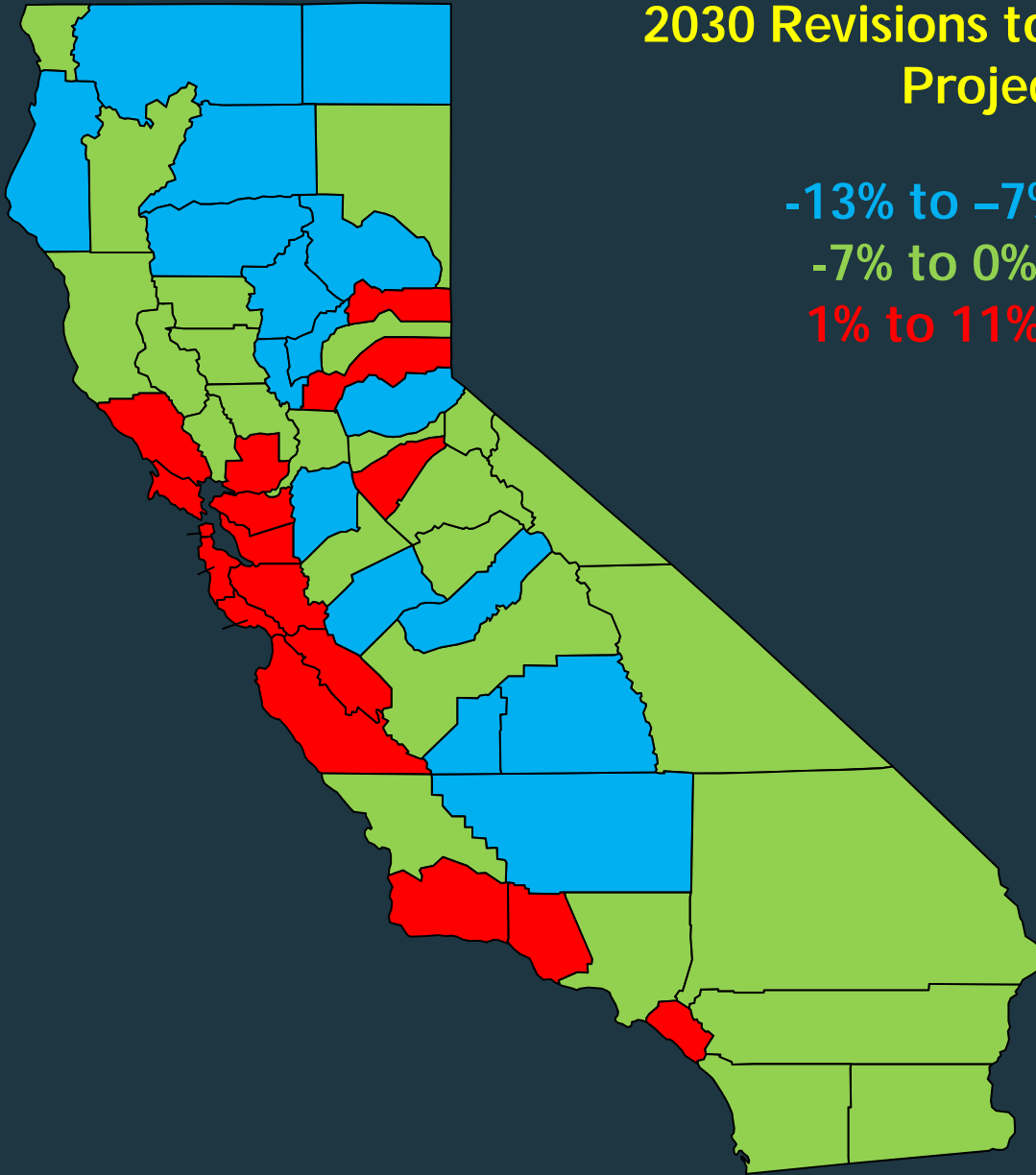

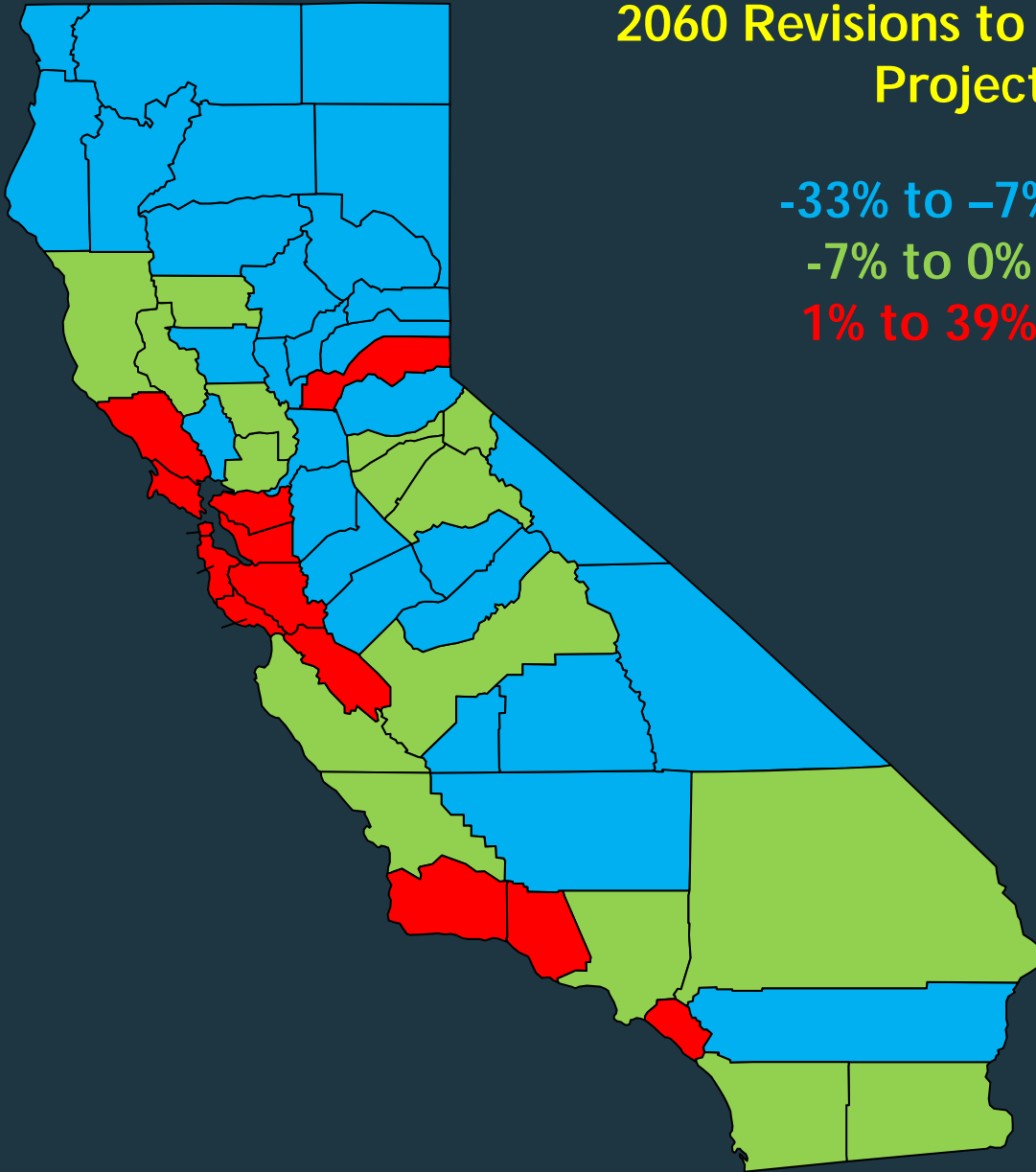
2030 Revisions to B11 Population Projections

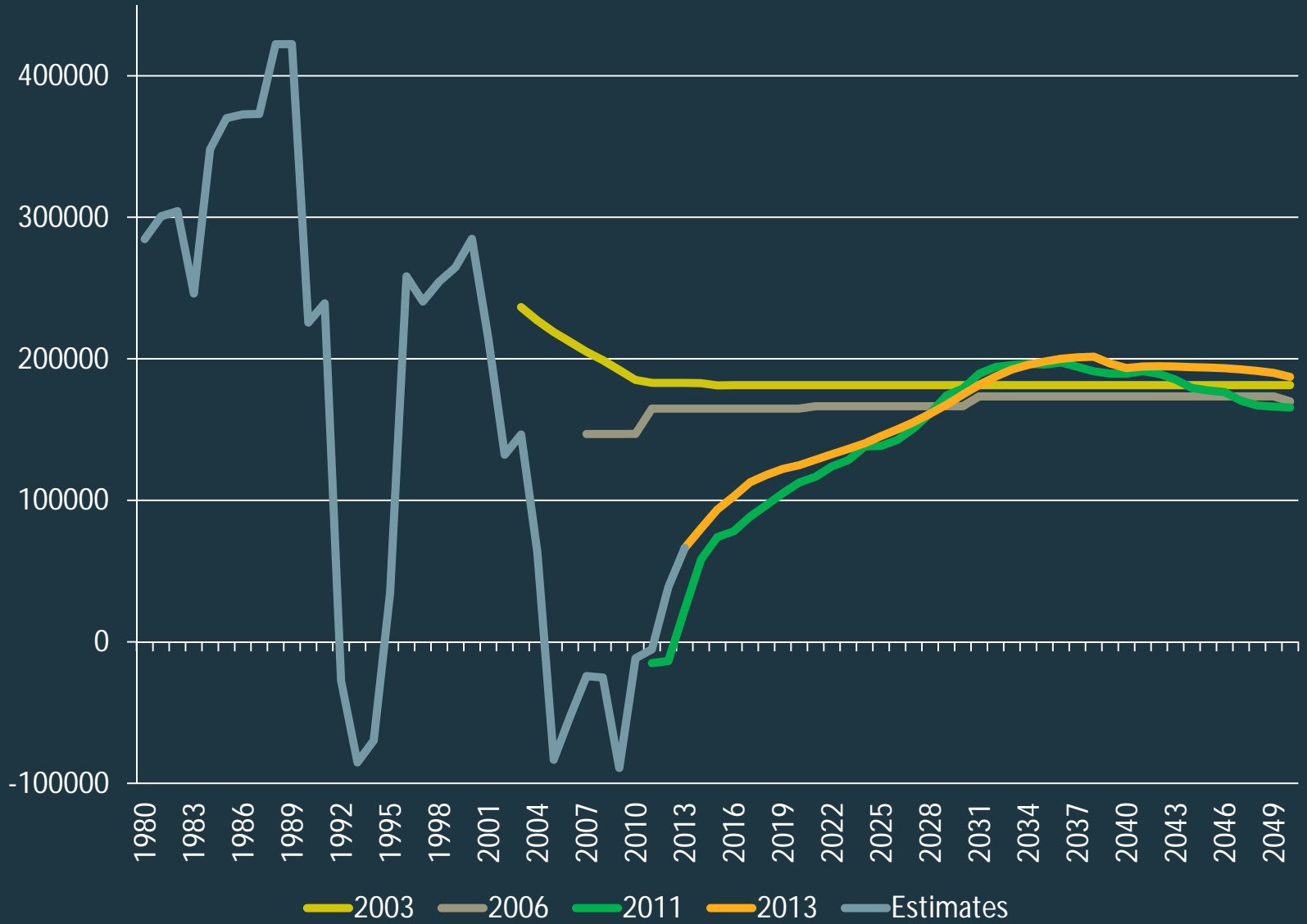


Differences

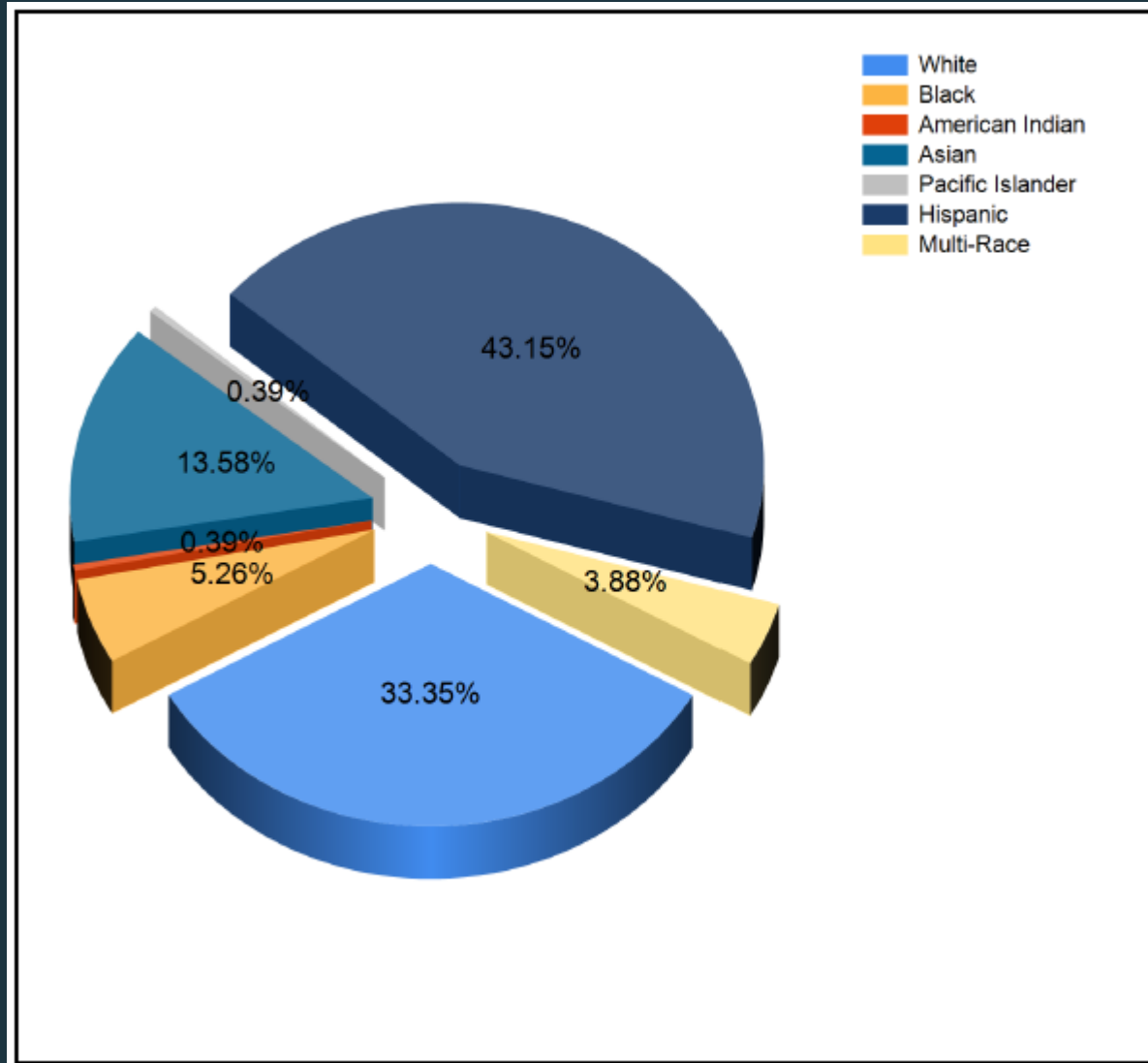

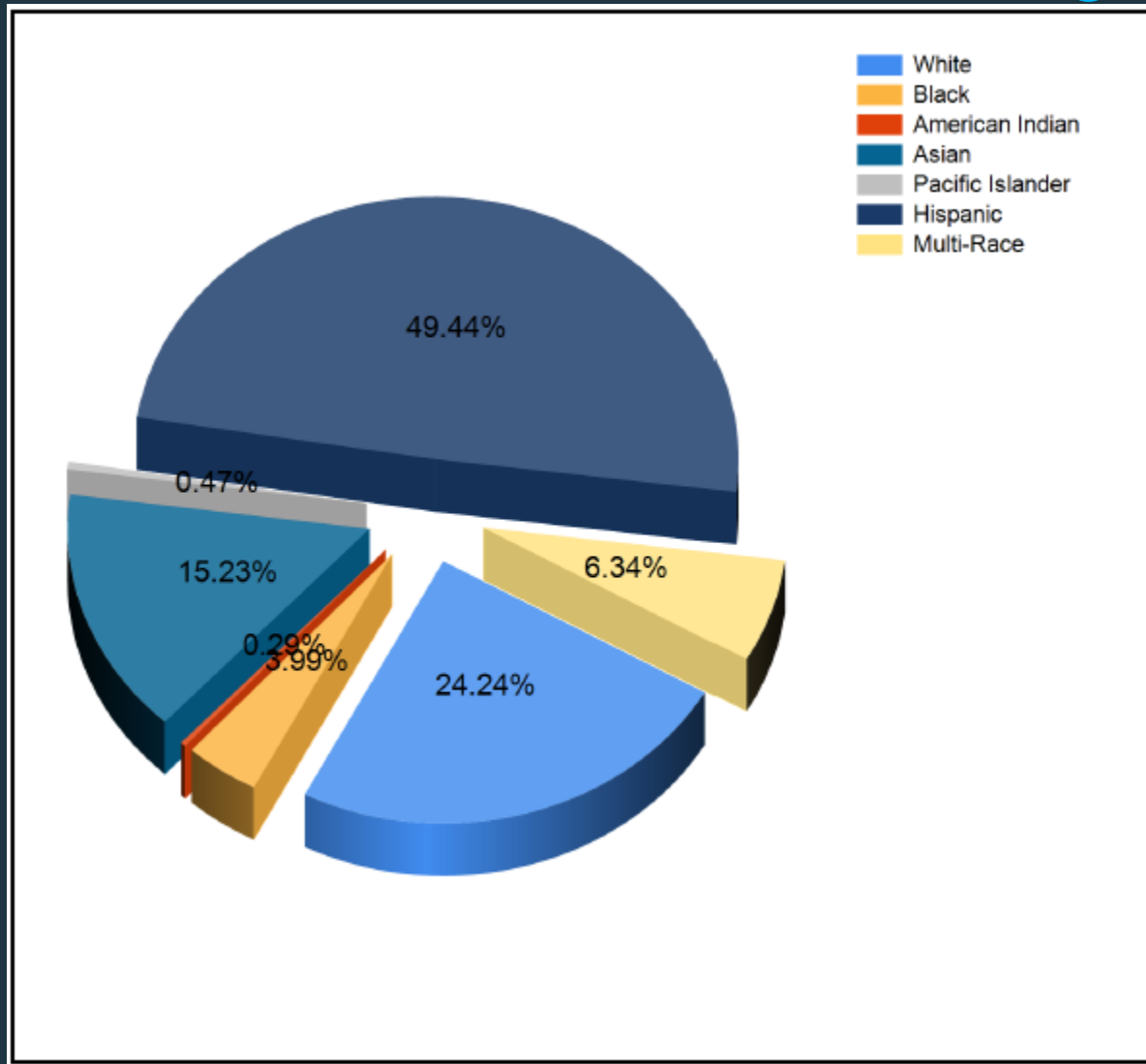
2010 Race/Ethnicity



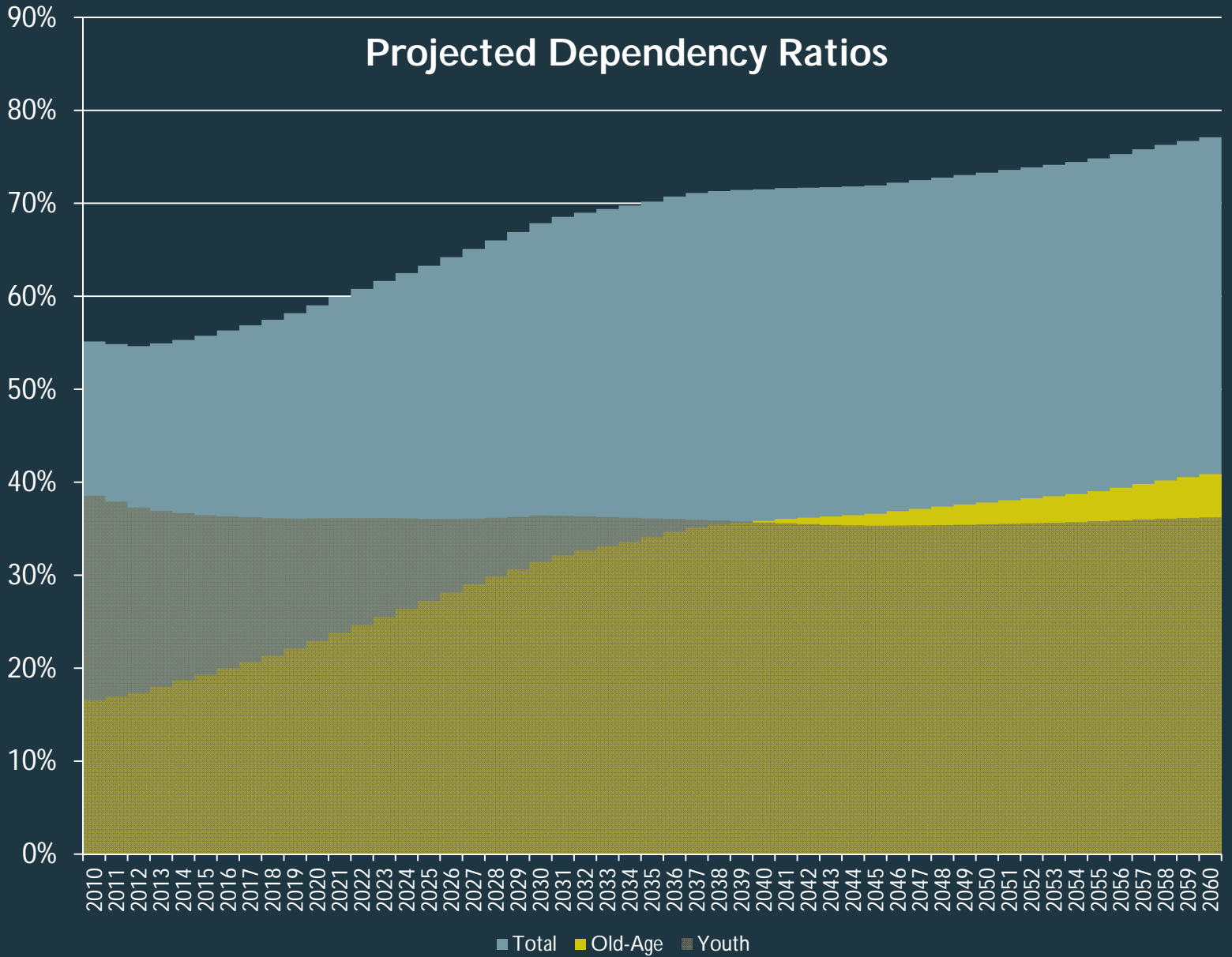
2030 Race/Ethnicity
