## State Active Transportation Program (ATP)

- To date: \$1.6 billion for 840 projects
- Key players: CTC, Caltrans, SCAG, Metro, project sponsors
- ATP Cycle 5
  - \$445 million across FY 22, FY 23, FY 24, and FY 25
  - Guidelines/Application Development: Fall/Winter 2019
  - Call for Projects: Spring 2020
- TIMS ATP Tool

## Metro ATP Grant Assistance

- > 50% of ATP funds in LA County are due to Metro Grant Assistance
- Approximately 30 slots available
- Apply through a Letter of Interest
  - Focus on first/last mile ATP projects
- Anticipated timeline:

October 2019 – January 2020	Letter of Interest submission period
February 2020	Project selection
February 2020 – March 2020	Project sponsor submits existing project data/information to Metro consultant
March/May 2020 – June/July 2020	Metro consultant prepares application, project sponsor reviews draft(s)

- Keeping the funds is critical
- Caltrans and Metro partner on Project Delivery Workshops
  - Goal: improve project delivery outcomes in LA County
  - 11 workshops between April 2019 and July 2019
  - Attendance from >100 staff representing 38 agencies
